## NOTES:

- (a) Ongoing target for FY11-12 reductions is \$325,556. A contingency target requires \$325,556 in additional cuts. These cuts have not been included in this chart. Contingency cuts will be taken from the City Grants Program.
- (b) Department salaries may change prior to July 1 based on any union agreements. Ongoing salary needs may impact the overall budget and cuts needed to meet target reductions.
- The VAW Grants Program will award contracts through a competetive Request for Proposals process, with a new contract year beginning July 1, 2011. A sample of how these reductions will impact current grantees has been attached. However, this should be considered an example only, and no agency should assume funding based on the amount in the attached spreadsheet. If the cuts were to be imposed on current-year contracts, a 15% cut would be applied to each program. This number is subject to change due to fluxuations in other areas of the Department's budget that have not yet been finalized, such as health care costs and work orders with other departments.
- (d) A 1-time appropriation of accrued Marriage License Fee revenue was applied toward shelter programs in FY10-11. In FY11-12, the allocation will revert to its standard amount of \$210,000, with 8% supporting the Department's administrative expenses, per ordinance.
- (e) Work orders from other departments have not yet been finalized in the budget system, and may change the total figures of this budget proposal.
