

HSN ENDORSEMENTS FOR THE NOVEMBER 2010 BALLOT

San Francisco

Yes on E: Election Day Voter Registration

Yes on I: Saturday Voting

Yes on J: Hotel Tax Clarification and Temporary Increase

No on K: Hotel Tax Clarification and Definitions

No on L: Sitting or Lying on Sidewalks

Yes on M: Community Policing and Foot Patrols

Yes on N: Real Property Transfer Tax

California

Yes on 22: Prohibits the State from Taking Funds Used for Transportation or Local Government Projects and Services

Yes on 24: Repeals Recent Legislation That Would Allow Businesses to Carry Back Losses, Share Tax Credits, and Use a Sales-Based Income Calculation to Lower Taxable Income

Yes on 25: Changes Legislative Vote Requirement to Pass a Budget from Two-Thirds to a Simple Majority. Retains Two-Thirds Vote Requirement for Taxes

No on 26: Increases Legislative Vote Requirement to Two-Thirds for State Levies and Charges. Imposes Additional Requirement for Voters to Approve Local Levies and Charges with Limited Exceptions

Not on this ballot: Yes to support the Close the Loophole campaign (Prop 13 split roll)
